



The 20th Annual 2022 “BIG-TOE” Hike of the Barefoot Mailman

Sunday, February 6, 2022

Who? Participants must be a registered Cub Scout, Scouts BSA, Venturer, other youth group, or a registered adult. Each Unit registering Scouts must register at least one adult hiker*.

What? On Sunday, February 6, 2022 the South Florida Council will mark the 20th Anniversary of the BIG-TOE Hike of the Barefoot Mailman. This 11-mile day-hike, along portions of the historic trails walked by the Barefoot Mailmen of the late 1800’s, provides opportunities for Cub Scouts, Webelos and younger Scouts to learn and practice hiking skills while hiking a portion of a Historic Trail Hike. Like the Barefoot Mailmen, participants in the hike are to maintain self-sufficiency (except water) as they hike the trail.

Where? Haulover Beach Park (10800 Collins Ave, Miami Beach, FL 33154) to South Beach, Miami Beach

When? Sunday, February 6, 2022. Check-in 6:30 – 7 AM. 1st Section step off at 7:30 AM.

REQUIREMENTS: CLASS-A UNIFORM! Each Unit registering Scouts must register at least one adult hiker*. Patches will be awarded to participants that successfully complete the hike.

REGISTRATION: Register online at sfcbsa.org/event-list/. Registration continues until January 27, 2022. After Jan. 27, only on-site (Saturday or Sunday morning Feb. 5 or Feb. 6) registrations will be allowed.

Cost? \$13 per person for early registration. Early registration closes January 20, 2022 and cost will be \$18 per person after January 20.
