Hiking Distance	Action	Location
0	Start	Parking lot adjacent to E Atlantic Blvd and N Pompano Beach Blvd. Section(S)-1 @ 5:30; S-2 @ 5:50; S-3 @ 6:10; S-4 @ 6:30; S-5 @ 6:50. Proceed South on Briny Ave to SE 8 St then Right to S Ocean Blvd. Left (south) on S Ocean Blvd.
3.09	Break-1	Turn left at Pine Ave, then south on El Mar Dr. Lauderdale By The Sea public restrooms are south of Commercial Blvd.
4.62	Break-2/ First Aid	South East corner Oakland Park Blvd. & A1A - restrooms in convenience store on west side of A1A.
	Barefoot Mailman Hike marker	A Barefoot Mailman Hike marker is located just north of the Ft. Lauderdale Beach parking lot.
8.53	Break-3	Parking lot at S. end of Ft. Lauderdale Beach - Break at restrooms, 1/2 way down Parking lot; WARNING: METERED PARKING. When departing, stay on the left sidewalk facing traffic. Do not cross A1A.
10	Hilton Marina	Walk over 17 th Street Bridge and turn left onto the ramp and left to the Hilton Marina. Hikers will be picked up by boats for transport to USCG Station Fort Lauderdale. Sections regroup at Pelican Pavilion in State Park. SUPPORT should meet Sections at Parking lot 6 (Pelican Pavilion) in north end of Dr. Von D. Mizell-Eula Johnson State Park – Support vehicle entrance fee waived with Barefoot Mailman Hike support vehicle placard.
10	Hikers Move to Beach Trail (Bathroom break only)	Sections regroup at Pelican Pavilion and proceed down Dr. Von D. Mizell-Eula Johnson Park on back dune trail or on the beach.
12.4	Break - Dania Beach Pier Park: S. End State Park Beach	Pavilion at south end of Dania Beach Pier Parking lot (Frank C. "Tootie" Adler Park) - SUPPORT - exit State Park, take 1st left after underpass, to park entrance. Hikers leave via dune path in front of buildings, go 1 block to paved beach front walk. This is the lunch area for Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, Section 1 lunch at Garfield.
16	Break at Harry Berry Park	Park with restrooms at end of beach walk on Azalea Terrace. Return to A1A.
17.6	Break	1 block PAST Hallandale Ave & water tower in "South City Beach Park". Restrooms available.
18.1	Enter Golden Beach	Stay on A1A south. Cross from east to west side, and remain on sidewalks along A1A.
19.6	Leave Golden Beach, Break	South end of Golden Beach - Break at W. Lehman Cswy underpass at 193rd St. SUPPORT - Parking area and break area available under the overpass.
22.9	End Day-1; Overnight	Haulover Park- north side of golf course. Enter Haulover Park via path from A1A. Continue to the "lighthouse" parking lot underpass, then across parking lot to camping area. Vehicles entering prior to 30 minutes before sundown (6:07 p.m.) need to use the Pay By Phone parking. \$7 parking fee.

SUNDAY MORNING		BAREFOOT & BIG TOE ROUTE
0	Start from Haulover Park, north of Golf Course	Big Toe Hikers, and Section 5 Step off at 7:30 AM, S-4 @ 7:45, S-3 @ 8:00, S-2 @ 8:15, S-1 @ 8:30. Vehicles left in Park after 8 a.m. need to pay the \$7 parking fee.
1.5	Cross over Halover Inlet & Hike Bal Harbor Beach & Surfside Dune walks	Turn NORTH at the south end of Haulover Cut Bridge, and walk back to Inlet. Turn EAST at inlet, and walk to Bal Harbour Dune Walk, and continue SOUTH through Surfside dune walk.
3.7	Return to A1A - Break-1 Collins and 87th St	Walk west through North Beach Oceanside Park to A1A to meet support vehicles - entrance 50 yds south of end of Surfside - SUPPORT meet group on Collins Ave, at 87th St.
	Miami Beach Boardwalk	Turn left at south side of North Beach Oceanside Park at 79 th Street. Proceed on boardwalk to 53 rd Street parking lot.
6.7	Break-2 - @ 53rd St parking lot	Fire station @ 53rd St - Restrooms on east end of lot - Hikers return to paver and raised boardwalk to Lummus Park.
8.7	Hikers continue South on paver boardwalk	Hikers continue south to end of raised boardwalk and on paver boardwalk to Lummus Park.
10	Break-3 @ Lummus Park (13-15 St) - All Sections Regroup	Gather in Lummus Park between 15th and 13th Streets. At 12:45 p.m. all hikers and Scouts with flags line up to proceed to finish at 21st Street Collins Park. AMERICAN & UNIT FLAGS ARE TO BE BROUGHT TO LUMMUS PARK!
11	Parade of Flags NORTH on Beach to 21st St Park	Hike ends at 21st St Park - Parking lot east of Collins Ave between 21st and 22nd St; Distribution of Patches and certificates - collection of mailbags and section flags - Estimated Time of dismissal 2:30 p.m.

In 1912, J. N. Lummus and his brother John Edgar, purchased 605 acres of swamp land that would become Lincoln Road to Government Cut. They built the Park for public use in 1909 and after Miami Beach incorporated in 1915, J. N. Lummus became the first Mayor. They sold the Park for a small down payment and a few thousand dollars for 20 years.

On December 21, 1926, John Newton Lummus Jr., son of the first Miami Beach Mayor, was elected Mayor. There were 1,807 registered voters. The South Florida Council awarded him with the Silver Beaver in 1941. In 1948, SFC awarded the Silver Beaver to Thomas J. Lummus, also a son of J. N. Lummus Sr.
