District Award of Merit: The highest award that is given to a Scouter at the District level and also the only "non-square knot" in the knot award group. The District Award of Merit is awarded by a District to volunteer and professional adults for service to youth in the district. A person may receive the District Award of Merit more than once from different districts but there are no provisions for wearing more than one. Career members of the Boy Scouts of America may receive this award upon concurrence of the Council Scout Executive and the Director of Operations at the National office, BSA.

Sawgrass V.I.P Award: (Very Important Parent) These are Parent's who by their actions and commitment to Scouting and their units have defined themselves as "Go-Getters" by always doing something positive for their unit and Scouting.

Cheerful Scouter: A Scouter who is always doing something positive for their unit and scouting and doing whatever it takes to get the job done, no matter how big or small the task, no matter what obstacle must be overcome. One who has a model attitude, big smile, is friendly and fair to all in spite of "Irritating Tasks" that befall us and upholding the principles and purposes of Scouting.

Lifesaver Award: For a Scouter who has come to the rescue of the district in a time of great need.

Horizon Award: One who has made contributions to the district over many years and continues to inspire and guide by freely sharing knowledge and experiences. Symbolizing Duty to God and Country and Duty to Others before Duty to Self. And is an inspiration and example to others in dress, speech, attitude, scout spirit and leadership.

Cubmaster of the Year Award: Cubmaster who has exemplified the role of Cubmaster in his/her Pack and goes above and beyond in their actions, attitudes, and knowledge of Scouting ways, is a role model and lives the Scout oath and law in his/her everyday life.

Scoutmaster of the Year Award: Scoutmaster who has exemplified the role of Scoutmaster in his/her Troop and goes above and beyond in their actions, attitudes, and knowledge of Scouting ways, is a role model and lives the Scout oath and law in his/her everyday life.

Advisor of the Year Award: Advisor who has exemplified the role of Advisor in his/her Crew and goes above and beyond in their actions, attitudes, and knowledge of Scouting ways, is a role model and lives the Scout oath and law in his/her everyday life.

Scouter of the Year Award: For significant all-around contributions and participation in Scouting at both the district and unit levels. Inspires and promotes scouting. Lives his/her everyday life by the Scout oath and law.
